

Known also fo its adsorption properties, toxins actually bind to the charcoal and are naturally eliminated. PLEASE NOTE: DO NOT TAKE WITH PRESCRIPTION MEDS. Severe constipation may result, offer plenty of fresh clean water. Please get a reputable brand from your health food store and follow the label for dosage instructions. Use half the child dose.
